

## **PADI Rescue Diver Course**

You've done your Advanced Open Water course, maybe had a few dives since where you've noticed you're diving, air consumption, awareness of your surroundings have all improved beyond measure. If you want to keep getting better the next step is taking your Rescue course.

Students enrolling on the PADI Rescue Diver course must have a valid up-to-date first aid cert. including CPR. (the one day Emergency First Response course, offered separately, is ideal ).

The Rescue Diver course takes place over four days (over two weekends). You'll learn to handle numerous diving emergencies through 10 training exercises culminating in four all encompassing 'Rescue scenarios' where all the skills you've learned are put into practice.

Those that enjoy Rescue Diver status are among the keenest of divers and are among the best-trained non-professionals hence their presence on dives of all levels is much sought.
